

Suicide Behavior Across Gender and Educational Streams (Jammu)

ABSTRACT

Youth suicide has been a constant problem for schools over the past three decades. For the present study Suicidal behaviors questionnaire-revised (SBQ-R, Osman et al. in 2001) has been used to study the levels of Suicide behavior across Gender and among Science and Commerce Students. A purposive sample of 60 was taken (30 males & 30 females), belonging to two educational groups i.e., science & commerce. The data were collected from Jammu city. The Present study found that there was a Non- significant difference in suicide orientation of students across gender as well as there is Non-significant difference in suicide orientation across educational groups ie. Science and commerce streams respectively.
