The present paper deals with the plant-based drugs used in veterinary practices in Karauli, Dholpur and Sawai Madhopur districts of Rajasthan in India. Tribal and traditional communities inhabiting these area are farmers and rear cattle for livelihood. There are no proper facilities of veterinary clinics in the interior areas. They rely mostly on the traditional system of medicine for health care of cattle and other domestic animals. The present paper enumerates uses of 72 plant species.
